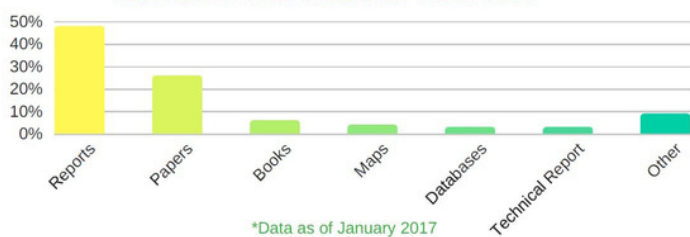
THE EUROPEAN INVENTORY ON GROUNDWATER RESEARCH IS NOW AVAILABLE

The KINDRA European Inventory on Groundwater Research (EIGR) is a tool for inventorying data sources regarding Hydrogeological Research Knowledge and Information.

It follows the principles defined by the KINDRA project Harmonised Terminology and Methodology for classification and reporting hydrogeology related research in Europe (HRC-SYS).

Now the EIGR has become available to all groundwater practitioners looking for information and wishing to share their research. Presently, more than 2300 records have been inserted, and near 2000 of them have been published and made available for consultation.

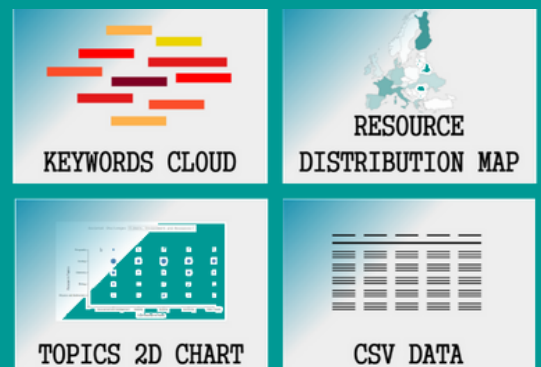

EIGR TOOLS

In order to keep building the functionalities of its novel inventory, the KINDRA consortium has now implemented a tool that allows for a quick assessment of the content of the EIGR. A direct link has been added to the KINDRA website in the EIGR page.

Kindra Queries include several visualization options for a rapid analysis of groundwater research:



- Keywords Cloud, for relative importance of keywords in Groundwater Research
- Resource Distribution Map, number of contributions to Hydrogeology Research published in the Inventory by European member states
- Topics 2D Chart, number of resources classified according to the main Hydrological Research Classification System (HRC-SYS) Topic Categories
- CSV format data export, filter out a number of resources according any specific term of interest



THIRD JOINT PANEL OF EXPERTS WORKSHOP

During the 20th and 21st of June, project partners met the members of the Joint Panel of Experts in La Palma to assess the latest developments of the project inventory (EIGR) and to plan options for its future.

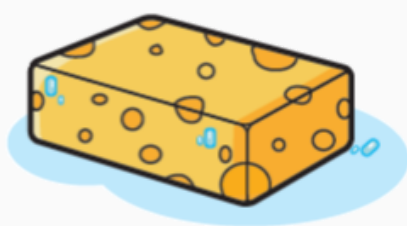
The workshop focused on themes such as the EIGR quick analysis tools, the search engine, the steps to be taken for adding metadata and the dissemination and communication activities for the next 6 months.



PUBLIC OUTREACH

KINDRA is also finalizing a series of interviews made to selected hydrogeologists of its Joint Panel of Experts with the objective of creating an overview of a hydrogeologist's day-to-day addressing young adults deciding on their career choice.
